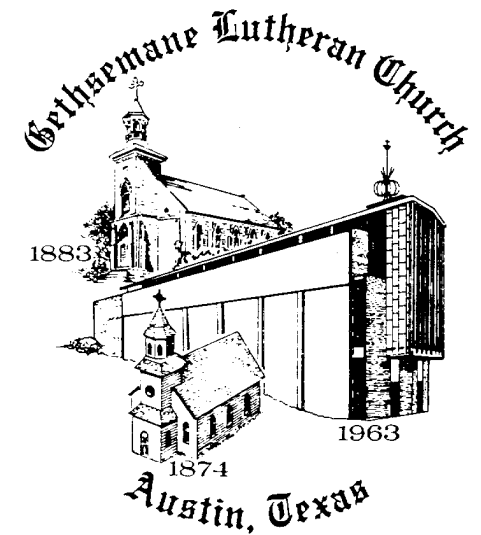


### DIRECTIONS

Take highway 290 West past the “Y” in Oak Hill, through the scenic hill country: go through Dripping Springs, Johnson City, Hye, Stonewall, Fredericksburg, ...turn left on highway 16 South to Kerrville, go straight through Kerrville, cross the river in town and go 8 miles south to FM 1273 (Upper Turtle Creek Road)...turn right by electric power station and go 1.5 miles ..speed up on the downgrade and hear the adults go “*Wheeee!*” Lutheran Camp Chrysalis is on the right! Allow 2.5 hours, plus your stopping time!! It really is a beautiful drive! It’s okay to stop and smell the flowers, unless we are too early this year!
